Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on July 18, 2017. Your complaint alleged that De'Sean Quinn may have violated Chapter 42.17A RCW for making false statements to the PDC and failing to provide detailed breakdowns of expenditures.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- De'Sean Quinn issued reimbursement checks in April 2017 for over-limit contributions. Verifiable and detailed documentation was provided to PDC Staff, as required by RCW 42.17A.750.
- Documentation of returned reimbursements was also included, and De'Sean Quinn worked diligently with PDC Staff to ensure that every dollar of over-limit contributions were properly reimbursed.
- The purpose descriptions for De'Sean Quinn's expenditures are sufficiently detailed to meet the disclosure requirements of RCW 42.17A.240 and WAC 390-16-037.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, no evidence supports a finding of a material violation warranting further investigation.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
