ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S  
REQUEST FOR REVIEW

13 This matter came before the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission on October  
14 26, 2017, at the PDC office, Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia,  
15 Washington. Respondent John Zingg requested review of the Commission Order issued on  
16 September 5, 2017 following a Brief Enforcement Hearing (brief adjudicative proceeding) in  
17 this matter. The matter was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and 42.17A RCW and  
18 Chapter 390-37 WAC.

19 Commissioners present included Anne Levinson, Commission Chair (presiding); Jack  
20 Johnson, Commission Vice-Chair; and Commissioners John Bridges, Katrina Asay, and David  
21 Ammons. Fox Blackhorn-Delph, PDC Compliance Coordinator, presented the matter of behalf  
22 of PDC Staff. Also present were Assistant Attorney General Scott Douglas representing the  
23 Commission; PDC Executive Director Peter Lavallee; Assistant Attorney General Chad  
24 Standifer on behalf of PDC Staff; and PDC staff member Jana Greer as recorder of the  
25 proceedings. Respondent's wife Debra Zingg participated by telephone in the proceeding on  
26 behalf of John Zingg. The proceeding was open to the public and recorded.

1 1. Respondent John Zingg has health issues which have resulted in his diminished mental  
2 capacity.

3 2. Respondent John Zingg has resigned his position as Freeman School District School  
4 Director.

5 **III. ORDER**

6 The \$250 civil penalty assessed against Mr. Zingg is hereby waived. The Executive  
7 Director is authorized to enter this order on behalf of the Commission.
