ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR REVIEW

Respondent.

This matter came before the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission on October 26, 2017, at the PDC office, Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia, Washington. Respondent Paul Mosbrucker requested review of the Commission Order issued on September 5, 2017 following a Brief Enforcement Hearing (brief adjudicative proceeding) in this matter. The matter was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and 42.17A RCW and Chapter 390-37 WAC.

Commissioners present included Anne Levinson, Commission Chair (presiding); Jack Johnson, Commission Vice-Chair; and Commissioners John Bridges, Katrina Asay, and David Ammons. Fox Blackhorn-Delph, PDC Compliance Coordinator, presented the matter on behalf of PDC Staff. Also present were Assistant Attorney General Scott Douglas representing the Commission; PDC Executive Director Peter Lavallee; Assistant Attorney General Chad Standifer on behalf of PDC Staff; and PDC staff member Jana Greer as recorder of the proceedings. Respondent Paul Mosbrucker did not participate in the proceeding. The proceeding was open to the public and recorded.

1	II. FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
2	Respondent's request for review is granted. The Findings of Fact and Conclusions of
3	Law entered on September 5, 2017 are hereby incorporated. Additionally, the Commission finds
4	that:
5	1. Respondent Paul Mosbrucker attempted in good faith to file the F-1 report for 2016 in
6	April 2017, and successfully submitted the report on July 31, 2017.
7	III. ORDER
8	The \$300 civil penalty assessed against Mr. Mosbrucker is hereby waived. The Executive
9	Director is authorized to enter this order on behalf of the Commission.
