ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S  
REQUEST FOR REVIEW

This matter came before the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission on October 26, 2017, at the PDC office, Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia, Washington. Respondent Paul Mosbrucker requested review of the Commission Order issued on September 5, 2017 following a Brief Enforcement Hearing (brief adjudicative proceeding) in this matter. The matter was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and 42.17A RCW and Chapter 390-37 WAC.

Commissioners present included Anne Levinson, Commission Chair (presiding); Jack Johnson, Commission Vice-Chair; and Commissioners John Bridges, Katrina Asay, and David Ammons. Fox Blackhorn-Delph, PDC Compliance Coordinator, presented the matter on behalf of PDC Staff.
