

File a Formal Complaint - Will Hall

On June 7, 2017, Carolyn Ahlgreen announced on a Facebook page titled "Carolyn Ahlgreen for Shoreline City Council" that she received a \$27

On June 12, 2017, Carolyn Ahlgreen certified and filed a C1 Candidate Registration form with the PDC in which she said she will use the full reporting system.

As of noon on July 7, 2017, the PDC website shows that the PDC has no detailed contribution information for Carolyn Ahlgreen.

A \$27 donation received by Carolyn Ahlgreen's campaign for Shoreline City Council on June 7, 2017, should have been deposited by June 14, 2017 (five business days) and reported to the PDC by June 19, 2017 (the following Monday).


Carolyn Ahlgreen is a candidate for Shoreline City Council. Her C1 Candidate Registration form filed June 12, 2017, says she will use the full reporting system, which requires filing reports by certain deadlines.

RCW 42.17A.220(1) requires that "All monetary contributions received by a candidate or political committee shall be deposited by the treasurer or deputy treasurer in a depository in an account established and designated for that purpose. Such deposits shall be made within five business days of receipt of the contribution."

RCW 42.17A.235(3) requires that "For the period beginning the first day of the fourth month preceding the date of the special election, or for the period beginning the first day of the fifth month before the date of the general election, and ending on the date of that special or general election, each Monday the treasurer shall file with the commission a report of each bank deposit made during the previous seven calendar days. The report shall contain the name of each person contributing the funds and the amount contributed by each person. However, persons who contribute no more than twenty-five dollars in the aggregate are not required to be identified in the report...."

The FAQs on the PDC website <https://www.pdc.wa.gov/learn/new-candidates> say, "C-3 Contribution Reports: Before June 1 of the election year, candidates fill out a C-3 report for each bank deposit and file these reports with their C-4 reports. Beginning June 1, each deposit must be reported no later than the following Monday. Since contributions must be deposited within 5 business days of receipt, active campaigns will make at least one weekly deposit."
