Enclosed is a copy of a letter sent to Will Hall concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) on July 7, 2017. The complaint alleged that you may have violated RCW 42.17A.220 by not depositing a contribution within five business days of receipt; and RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by not filing C-3 and C-4 reports to report campaign contributions and expenditures. A copy of the complaint was previously sent to you.

As noted in the letter to Mr. Hall, the PDC will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking enforcement action in this matter. However, please be reminded that in future election campaigns, you need to carefully follow the requirements of the reporting option selected.
