Please accept this as a formal complaint to the Public Disclosure Commission concerning NW Architects of the Revolution, a Washington State political action committee.

The "Architects" sent out a mailing supporting Amy Glaser for Whatcom County Council District 2 that arrived at voters' houses on Saturday, June 17. According to RCW 42.17A.305, a C6 report is required within 24 hours of the piece being presented to the public. This report was not filed in the required time period.

Additionally, the piece is required to list the top five contributors, according to RCW 42.17A.320 (5). This piece is clearly in violation of that rule.

I have attached the piece in question. I would appreciate your prompt attention to this matter.


