

To Whom It May Concern –

It has come to my attention that Pedro Olguin has committed violations of **RCW 42.17A** in his 2017 campaign for the Burien City Council.

1) Failure to file timely, accurate contribution and expenditure reports. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235)

When Pedro Olguin filed his C1 on 4/11/2017, he selected the full reporting option. This indicates that he intended to file frequent, detailed campaign reports as required by law.

Unfortunately, Olguin has **failed to file ANY contribution or expenditure reports** -- a serious violation of state law.

While browsing through Brenda Weist's L2s, I noticed she reported that Teamsters 117 reported donating \$1000 to Olguin's campaign for Burien City Council (see attached).

Unfortunately, Olguin has not reported this (or any other) contribution to his campaign. Who knows how many secret, unreported contributions have been made already and kept hidden from the PDC and the public?


Additionally, Olguin has failed to report any of his various campaign expenditures, including, but not limited to, his fliers. Attached, please find a flier that Olguin's campaign distributed at Burien Strawberry Festival on June 17, 2017, and possibly elsewhere in the city.

Additionally, while it may not be part of the PDC's jurisdiction, **it should be noted that Olguin is not eligible to run for office in Burien, as he is a resident of Auburn.**

I have reason to believe there are other provisions of **RCW 42.17A** that have been violated or are being violated by Olguin's campaign. The PDC and AG's office should conduct a thorough review of Olguin's campaign to identify all violations. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you need any additional information. I find this one to be an interesting and odd campaign.


