

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that the Washington Teamsters Legislative League has violated **RCW 42.17A**.

**1) Failure to report contribution/reimbursement received. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240)**

In response to a complaint I filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (**PDC Tracking#16801**), De'Sean Quinn claimed to have reimbursed several committees that he received large over limit contributions from.

In his response to the complaint, Quinn claimed to have sent these reimbursements back to the following committees on the following dates:

- **SEIU 1199 NW \$950 refunded April 27, 2017**
- **Washington Teamsters Legislative \$950 refunded April 27, 2017**
- Great Wall Investment Group \$50 refunded April 27, 2017
- Martha Kongsgaard \$50 refunded April 27, 2017
- **MLK Jr. County Labor Council \$50 refunded April 27, 2017**

(Political committees in bold)

If we are to accept Quinn's statement to the PDC as true, then the Teamsters Legislative League should have received and deposited this reimbursement in May. Unfortunately, this was not reported on any of the relevant C4s filed by the Committee.

The PDC should investigate the possibility that the Washington Teamsters Legislative League committed the above violations maliciously, which would be a class C felony per **RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c)**. If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately.
