Subject: Complaint filed against Comcast PAC, PDC Case 20936

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on June 13, 2017. Your complaint alleged that the Comcast PAC made a \$3,800 contribution to the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign in December of 2015, but that Comcast PAC failed to file an Out-of-State Committee report (C-5 report) as required in accordance with RCW 42.17A.250.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations in light of PDC laws and rules in order to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. Staff reviewed: (1) your complaint; (2) the PDC database for contribution information for Comcast; and (3) communications with Phil Lloyd, Treasurer for the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On January 7, 2016, the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign (Campaign) timely filed a Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) with the PDC disclosing that on December 7, 2016, the Campaign received a \$3,800 monetary contribution from Comcast PAC, and attributed \$1,900 for the 2016 Primary Election, and \$1,900 for the 2016 General Election.
- Mr. Lloyd stated that when the contribution was data entered by staff, the word PAC was inadvertently added to the end of the Comcast contribution. He confirmed that the contribution was made by Comcast using corporate funds, and indicated that the Campaign has filed an amended C-3 report removing the word PAC from the contribution, and listing the contributor as Comcast Financial Agency Corp.

PDC staff concluded that a C-5 report was not required to have been filed by Comcast, and a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this instance is not warranted. Therefore, PDC is returning your complaint filed against Comcast without taking any action.
