Subject: Complaint filed against Capella Healthcare Government Affairs, PDC Case 20934

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on June 13, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Capella Healthcare Government Affairs (Capella) made a \$500 contribution to the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign in November of 2015, but that Capella PAC failed to file an Out-of-State Committee report (C-5 report) as required in accordance with RCW 42.17A.250.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations in light of PDC laws and rules in order to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. Staff reviewed: (1) your complaint; (2) the PDC database for contribution information for Capella; and (3) communications with Phil Lloyd, Treasurer for the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On December 9, 2015, the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign (Campaign) timely filed a Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) with the PDC disclosing that on November 19, 2015, the Campaign received a \$500 monetary contribution from Capella Healthcare Government Affairs.
- Mr. Lloyd stated the Capella contribution did not have word PAC added when the Campaign filed the C-3 report, and that the contributions was disclosed as “Capella Healthcare Government Affairs.” He confirmed that the contribution was made by Capella using corporate funds.

PDC staff concluded that a C-5 report was not required to have been filed by Capella Healthcare Government Affairs, and a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this instance is not warranted. Therefore, PDC is returning your complaint filed against Capella Healthcare Government Affairs Comcast without taking any action.
