PRELIMINARY RESPONSE BY PACIFIC MERCHANT SHIPPING ASSOCIATION

In the Matter Of: *Allegation by Glen Morgan on June 13, 2017 of One Violation of RCW 42.17A.250 by the PMSA Washington State PAC (#20796)*

Dear Compliance Officer Young,

On behalf of the Pacific Merchant Shipping Association (“PMSA”), I respectfully file this preliminary response to the allegation and claims made by Mr. Glen Morgan on June 13, 2017 against the PMSA Washington State PAC (“PAC”). Mr. Morgan’s allegation and claims should be dismissed upon investigation by the PDC as they are contradicted by the law and evidentiary review.

Mr. Morgan alleges:

- One specific singular violation of RCW 42.17A.250 for failure of the PMSA Washington State PAC to file an “Out-Of-State” Committee Report (PDC Form C-5) in connection with one particular contribution made by the PAC to the campaign of Dave Upthegrove for Public Lands Commissioner on June 6, 2016.
- That the PMSA Washington State PAC “chose to violate the law,” “decided not to register with the PDC,” and that it is an “unregistered political committee.”

The Facts:

The entirety of Mr. Morgan’s evidence submitted with his allegation is one reference to the contribution in June 2016 by the PAC to the Upthegrove campaign (PDC doc Ref #100701165). PMSA stipulates to the fact that the PMSA Washington State PAC made this contribution to the Upthegrove campaign in June 2016.

Mr. Morgan has submitted no other evidence whatsoever regarding any filing activity by the PAC.

The relevant evidence regarding the PAC is as follows:

- The “Pacific Merchant Shipping Association Washington State PAC” is registered with the PDC. A true and correct copy of the PAC’s C1PC form, filed with the PDC on May 11, 2015, is attached as Exhibit 1.
- The PAC is operating in Washington as a “Continuing Committee” and is obligated to complete “Full Reporting” of its activities. See Exhibit 1.
- The PAC disclosed the June 2016 Upthegrove contribution on its C4 Report covering the period from 06/01/16 – 07/11/16, which was filed with the PDC on July 12, 2016. A true and correct copy of the PAC’s C4 form, filed with the PDC on July 12, 2016, is attached as Exhibit 2.
- PMSA received an Electronic Filing Confirmation that the PAC’s C4 form filed on July 12, 2016 was received. A true and correct copy of the Electronic Filing Confirmation received from the PDC on July 12, 2016 is attached as Exhibit 3.
- The Pacific Merchant Shipping Association is a non-profit, mutual benefit corporation organized to represent the interests of the maritime industry on the U.S. West Coast and maintains offices and staff in Washington state.¹
- The PAC has been registered with the PDC at PMSA’s headquarters in Oakland, California, but is managed locally out of PMSA’s offices in Seattle, Washington, and filing for the PAC is handled by Heather Clarke, of Tumwater, Washington. See Exhibit 1.
- PMSA has a separately organized PAC in California, which is run independently of, and not used as a source of funds for, campaigns in Washington state. See <http://cal-access.sos.ca.gov/Campaign/Committees/Detail.aspx?id=1243454>.

The Allegations Are False Because As an In-State Continuing Political Committee, RCW 42.17A.250 Is Inapplicable to the PMSA Washington State PAC

Mr. Morgan’s chief allegation is that “a major violation of **RCW 42.17A.250** may have been committed by out of state political committee ‘**PMSA Washington State PAC**’ **located in San Francisco, California** during the 2016 election campaign season.” (emphasis in original).

¹ If necessary or requested by the PDC in the course of its investigation, PMSA would be more than happy to provide sworn declarations or verified statements to support this and other facts as alleged herein. Such formal evidentiary documentation has been dispensed with in this initial communication given the informal nature of the complaint itself, and because the most relevant exhibits are already in the possession of the PDC and/or available to the public generally.

This allegation is false because the PMSA Washington State PAC is not an out of state political committee. The regulations which further interpret and implement RCW 42.17A.250, at WAC 390-16-049, make the requirements of this statute plain (excerpts, with emphasis added):

- (1) **RCW 42.17A.250 governs campaign reporting in Washington state by committees located outside of Washington ... (and that is not otherwise required to report as an in-state committee)**
...
- (2) **To file as an out-of-state political committee, all the criteria in (a) and (b) of this subsection must be satisfied:**
 - (a) Out-of-state. First, the committee must be located out-of-state. **It must be maintaining its office or headquarters in another U.S. state or the District of Columbia, and has no office, street address or corporate registered agent in Washington state.**
...
 - (b) Organizational purpose and campaign activities. **Second, the committee must also be currently organized primarily for engaging in campaign activities in another state.**
...
- (3) **A committee that does not satisfy the criteria in subsection (2) of this section shall file as an in-state committee** under chapter 42.17A RCW, including RCW 42.17A.205 through 42.17A.240.
...

Upon application of the facts in this case, the PAC satisfies neither of the criteria in subsection (2) of WAC 390-16-049. PMSA maintains an office in Seattle, Washington and its Washington State PAC is organized exclusively for engaging in campaign activities in Washington state (just as the PMSA California PAC engages exclusively in California affairs). As RCW 42.17A.250 is inapplicable to the PAC and, therefore, it is impossible for the PAC to be in violation of this section.

The PAC is required to file as an in-state committee, subject to RCW 42.17A.205 through RCW 42.17A.240. As a continuing committee, the PMSA Washington State PAC operates under these sections to file and make disclosures to the PDC, and does not ever file a Form C-5 as required of an out-of-state committee.

Obviously, Mr. Morgan's claims that the PAC is "illegally unregistered" and "chose to violate the law and decided to not register with the PDC" are simply untrue.

The PMSA Washington State PAC Has Properly Disclosed All Of Its Contributions, Including Those to the Upthegrove Campaign, to the Public

Both the PAC and the Upthegrove Campaign properly reported the contribution of the PAC to the Campaign. Mr. Morgan's allegations of non-reporting violations under 42.17A.250 notwithstanding, the public was informed by both the contributor (the PAC on its C4 Report filed on July 12, 2016) and by the recipient of this contribution.

This campaign contribution disclosure met all of the technical requirements of the PDC and fulfilled the declaration of policy for Chapter 42.17A, whereby “political campaign ... contributions ... [are] fully disclosed to the public and that secrecy is to be avoided.” RCW 42.17A.001 (1).

The filings of the PAC which detail its status, including its Form C1PC, are available to the public under RCW 42.17A.050 in addition to being accessible generally through the PDC website. Had Mr. Morgan availed himself of not just the donee’s reports (the filings by the Upthegrove campaign) but also searched the PDC website for the donor’s reports (the filings by the PAC), surely this unnecessary complaint could have been avoided in its entirety.

Reservation of Rights

Given the facts and law, PMSA considers any further action by Mr. Morgan in this matter under RCW 42.17A.765 (4) as frivolous and advanced without reasonable cause. PMSA reserves all rights and privileges should this matter progress. Such reservation of rights may include compensation for all fees and costs expended in this and any further related administrative or judicial action on this matter under RCW 4.84.185 and CR 11.

Conclusion

PMSA respectfully requests that upon review all of the evidence offered by the complainant, Mr. Morgan, and in this preliminary response, consideration of the question of whether or not RCW 42.17A.250 can be violated by an in-state continuing political committee, and determination of whether or not PMSA properly disclosed its contribution of June 2016 to the Upthegrove campaign, that this investigation recommend the denial of this complaint.
