Subject: Complaint filed against Javdan Medical PC, PDC Case 20792

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on June 13, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Javdan Medical PAC made a \$200 contribution to the 2016 Cyrus Habib for Lieutenant Governor Campaign in November of 2015, but that Javdan Medical PAC failed to file an Out-of-State Committee report (C-5 report) as required in accordance with RCW 42.17A.250.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations in light of PDC laws and rules in order to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. Staff reviewed: (1) your complaint; (2) the PDC database for contribution information for Javdan Medical PC; and (3) communications with Jason Bennett, Treasurer for the 2016 Cyrus Habib for Lieutenant Governor Campaign.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On November 25, 2015, the 2016 Cyrus Habib for Lieutenant Governor Campaign (Campaign) timely filed a Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) with the PDC disclosing that on November 15, 2015, the Campaign received a \$200 monetary contribution from Javdan Medical PC.
- Mr. Bennett stated when the Campaign filed the C-3 report, the contribution was properly disclosed as "Javdan Medical PC", and the contributor information did not include the word "PAC." The contribution clearly stated PC indicating a Professional Corporation or Professional Service Corporation.

PDC staff concluded that a C-5 report was not required to have been filed by Javdan Medical PC, and a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this instance is not warranted. Therefore, PDC is returning your complaint filed against Javdan Medical PC without taking any action.
