Subject: Complaint filed against International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers PAC, PDC Case 20786

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on June 13, 2017. Your complaint alleged that the International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers PAC (Committee) made a \$2,000 contribution to Jay Inslee, a candidate seeking re-election to the office of Governor in Washington State in 2016, but that the Committee failed to file an Out-of-State Committee Report (C-5 report) as required in accordance with RCW 42.17A.250.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations listed in the complaint, the statutes, rules and reporting requirements, the PDC database for contribution information, and the C-5 report filed by the Committee. Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On October 28, 2016, the Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign timely filed a Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) with the PDC disclosing that the Campaign received a \$2,000 monetary contribution from the Committee on October 27, 2016 and deposited the funds into the campaign bank account on October 28, 2016.
- On November 14, 2016, the Committee timely filed a C-5 report disclosing a \$2,000 monetary contribution was made to the Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign on October 21, 2016.
- In your complaint, you alleged that PDC Report #100730986 was a C-3 report filed by the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign on July 14, 2016 disclosing a \$2,000 contribution from the Committee, but when PDC staff queried Report #100730986 which you provided, it linked to the October 28, 2016 C-3 report filed by the Campaign as detailed in the first bullet above.

Based on these facts, staff has determined that the Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers PAC timely filed the C-5 report as required for an out-of-state political committee and has dismissed the complaint in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
