Subject: Complaint filed against Lockheed Martin, PDC Case 20716

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on June 13, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Lockheed Martin made a \$500 contribution to the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign in October of 2013, but that Lockheed Martin failed to file an Out-of-State Committee report (C-5 report) as required in accordance with RCW 42.17A.250.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations in light of PDC laws and rules in order to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. Staff reviewed: (1) your complaint; (2) the PDC database for contribution information for Lockheed Martin; (3) Lobbying Reports filed by Lockheed Martin; and (4) communications with Phil Lloyd, Treasurer for the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign. Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On February 28, 2001, Lockheed Martin filed an Annual Employer's Lobbying Expense Report (L-3 report) and an Employer of Lobbyist Monthly Contribution Report (L-3c report) disclosing Lockheed Martin lobbying activities undertaken and political contributions made in Washington State during calendar year 2000. No additional lobbying reports have been filed by Lockheed Martin since those reports were filed in 2001.
- On November 12, 2013, the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign (Campaign) timely filed a Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) with the PDC disclosing that on October 7, 2013, the Campaign received a \$500 monetary contribution from the Lockheed Martin PAC.
- Mr. Lloyd stated that when the contribution was data entered by staff, the word PAC was inadvertently added to the end of the Lockheed Martin contribution. He confirmed that the contribution was made by Lockheed Martin with corporate funds, and indicated that the Campaign has filed an amended C-3 report removing the word PAC from the Lockheed Martin contribution.



PDC staff concluded that a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this instance is not warranted.


The 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign confirmed that Lockheed Martin used corporate funds to make the contribution, so no C-5 report was required to have been filed for that contribution. Therefore, PDC is returning your complaint filed against Lockheed Martin without taking any action.
