Subject: Complaint filed against Millennium Pharmaceuticals, PDC Case 20714

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on June 13, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Millennium Pharmaceuticals made a \$1,800 contribution to the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign in December of 2013, but that Millennium Pharmaceuticals failed to file an Out-of-State Committee report (C-5 report) as required in accordance with RCW 42.17A.250.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations in light of PDC laws and rules in order to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. Staff reviewed: (1) your complaint; (2) the PDC database for contribution and expenditure information for Millennium Pharmaceuticals; and (3) communications with Phil Lloyd, Treasurer for the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign. Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On January 8, 2014, the 2016 Jay Inslee for Governor Campaign (Campaign) timely filed a Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) with the PDC disclosing that on December 10, 2013, the Campaign received a \$1,800 monetary contribution from Millennium Pharmaceuticals which was attributed to the 2016 primary election.
- Mr. Lloyd stated that the Millennium Pharmaceuticals contribution was refunded by the Campaign in January of 2014.
- On February 10, 2014, the Campaign timely filed the January 2014 Summary Full Report of Contributions and Expenditures (C-4 report) disclosing an \$1,800 expenditure to refund the contribution made by Millennium Pharmaceuticals PAC.

PDC staff concluded that a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this instance is not warranted. The Campaign timely refunded the \$1,800 contribution from Millennium Pharmaceuticals PAC, so no C-5 report was required to have been filed for that contribution.

Therefore, PDC is returning your complaint filed against Millennium Pharmaceuticals without taking any action.
