Their response is attached for convenience. They appear to be defiantly refusing to provide what I believe is required information.

On 8/31/2018 3:00 PM, PDC Support wrote:

Hi Jim,

Thanks for writing in about reporting campaign expenditures. In answer to your question, yes, a detailed description of goods and/or services is required to be provided by the recipient of the expenditure.

An excerpt from WAC 390-16-037 explains:

(3) Describe in detail the goods and/or services to be provided by the recipient of the expenditure...

Example B: If an expenditure is for printing, the purpose shall include the following details:

Vendor Name	Purpose	Amount
ABC Printing	5,000 brochures	\$3,000
