Subject: Complaint regarding Tony Guzman, PDC Case 19198

Dear John Orozco:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on May 24, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Tony Guzman may have violated RCW 42.17A.555 by using his public office and email for his political campaign and conducting electioneering communication within City Hall.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff’s initial review, we found the following:

- Per WAC 390-37-040, every complaint must include clear statements of the alleged violations, evidence to support the allegations, and contact information for any witnesses that may be able to support the allegations.
- On June 2, 2017, PDC Staff requested the above information in order to bring your complaint up to the minimum standard set by WAC 390-37-040 .
- The necessary evidence or information in order to continue assessing the allegations in your complaint has not been received by June 8, 2018.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, no evidence supports a finding of a material violation warranting further investigation.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
