Subject: Complaint regarding City of Seattle, PDC Case 18341

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on May 15, 2017. Your complaint alleged that the City of Seattle may have violated RCW 42.17A.570 by failing to timely file the annual treasurer's statement (T-1 form) for the 2016 calendar year.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- The Treasurer failed to timely file the required T-1 form for calendar year 2016.
- The City of Seattle acknowledged its oversight, and filed their required T-1 form on June 22, 2017 for CY 2016.

Based on these initial findings, PDC staff has concluded that a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this instance is not warranted. While the City of Seattle was untimely in their filing, they have been forthright in acknowledging their oversight and diligently worked with Commission staff to get back into compliance. It does not appear that substantial harm was caused to the public for this lack of disclosure.

PDC staff is reminding the City of Seattle about the importance of the timely and accurate filing of the annual T-1 form.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
