The complaint alleged that you may have violated RCW 42.17A.710 for failure to accurately disclose personal financial affairs by failing to report social security income, and Pierce Transit board income on the supplement to your F-1 statement of personal financial affairs. Dear Dave Churchman:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on May 8, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Daryl Eidingen may have violated RCW 42.17A.710 for failure to accurately disclose personal financial affairs by failing to report social security income, and Pierce Transit board income on the supplement to his F-1 statement of personal financial affairs.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Daryl Eidingen failed to report social security income for his spouse and himself as well as board income from Pierce Transit RCW 42.17A.710.
- Daryl Eidingen serves on the board of Pierce Transit in his official capacity as a representative for Fife, Milton, and Edgewood. The per diem rate of \$90 per meeting, totaling \$1980 in 2016 would not trigger a reporting requirement under RCW 42.17A.710(1)(g) per guidance issued by the Public Disclosure Commission at its May 25, 2017 public meeting.
- Daryl Eidingen promptly corrected his filings upon notification, and does not have any prior violations of Chapter 42.17A RCW or Title 390 WAC.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to report income does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Daryl Eidingen about the importance of the complete, timely, and accurate filing of all future PDC reports, including the F-1 report. Therefore, PDC is returning your complaint filed against Daryl Eidingen without taking any action.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
