

In November 2014, Jackie Murray, identified as a representative of Respect Washington, submitted a petition to the Spokane City Clerk's Office (Initiative No. 2015-1). A copy is available at <http://pjals.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/09/2015-Respect-Washington-Initiative-Petition.pdf>. The Petition and all communication with the City indicate that the sponsoring organization is Respect Washington.

Eventually, Respect Washington obtained enough signatures and the measure will be placed on the November 2017 Spokane City Ballot at Proposition 1.

A review of the PDC database indicate: (1) there is an political committee identified as Respect Washington and one identified as Respect WA with the same identified people associated with both; (2) neither political committee has identified itself as working on Spokane Proposition 1; and (3) expenses identified in the 2015 filings for Respect WA (not Respect Washington) are associated with the petition gathering process, but do not identify that the effort is associated with this campaign and do not match the identified sponsoring political committee (Respect Washington) that appears on the petitions and other materials.

All expenses associated with Proposition 1 need to be properly reported with the correct sponsoring political committee (Respect Washington) and the political committee needs to disclose that it is working on Spokane Proposition 1.
