As noted in the letter to Glen Morgan, the PDC will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking further enforcement action in this matter.

PDC staff is reminding you about the importance of the timely disclosure of all contribution and expenditure activities at the time of candidate registration, including items such as the candidate filing fee and post office box rental for any future election campaign.

Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on May 1, 2017. Your complaint alleged that that the Bill Fishburn may have violated Chapter 42.17A RCW for failure to accurately and timely report contributions, expenditures, endorsements, and committee officers.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Candidate Bill Fishburn failed to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports on the fate the treasurer was designated, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235(1).
- Candidate Bill Fishburn is a first-time filer, whose late disclosed initial contributions constituted a small percentage of overall contributions and expenditures.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to timely report initial contributions and expenditures does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
