

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that Daryl Eidinge has violated a provision of **RCW 42.17A** during his campaign to become the Mayor of Edgewood in 2015.

RCW 42.17A.320 (1) requires that: "All written political advertising, whether relating to candidates or ballot propositions, shall include the sponsor's name and address. All radio and television political advertising, whether relating to candidates or ballot propositions, shall include the sponsor's name."

Unfortunately, in the attached mailer, Daryl Eidinge failed to properly identify both the sponsor of the communication and the address it was coming from.

Mr. Eidinge is not a first-time candidate, having previously run for Edgewood City Council. He knows better but with wilful maliciousness failed to comply with state law.

I request that the PDC investigate and take action against Daryl Eidinge for this significant violation of state law.

WHERE I STAND


- ★ I do not have a personal agenda nor do I own parcels of land on Meridian. I want to serve you.

- ★ Your water district will remain independently owned, by you.


