Good Morning,

Thanks for your reply.

Just to provide more information, I'll address each of the allegations.

1) *The allegation regarding not reporting my PERS account is incorrect - I have no PERS account. NOTE: the editorial comments included in this allegation are also false.*

2) Failure to acknowledge understanding of RCW 42.17A.555. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.700 (7))

State law requires that incumbents for public office check a box on their F1 acknowledging

applicable statutes prohibiting misuse of public money for campaign purposes.

On his F1 covering 2015, Anderson did not check this box – a violation of state law. Anderson must submit an amended F1 to fix this error immediately.

I took a look at the electronic copy of my 2015 F1, and there are two "x's" beside the acknowledgment. I can email you an electronic copy of this form to show you what I mean. I believe this should satisfy the requirement. ***The electronic copy I looked at below was my 2016 F1. When I opened my 2015 F1, I found that none of the information I entered was saved, so I have no way of confirming whether or not I checked the box. I generally just update the prior year's F1 (unless the form has changed), in which I checked the box, so I believe the box must have been checked.***

If not; I acknowledge that I hold a local elected office. I have read and am familiar with RCW 42.17A.555 regarding the use of public facilities in campaigns.

3) Failure to disclose offices held. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.700, see WAC 390-24-010, 150)

State law requires that elected officials disclose the positions that they hold on corporations.

By his own admission, Tony Anderson is a board member of the organization "Puget Sound Access".

Unfortunately, he failed to report this on his F1, which is also a violation of state law.

Puget Sound Access is a 501c3 non-profit, and I receive no compensation for being on the board. It was not my understanding that this was the type of corporation that this section was referring to. As this is a financial affairs form, I did not feel it was necessary to report a volunteer position. I will revise my F1 if I am mistaken, just let me know.

4) *This allegation is incorrect. I reported the correct amount of compensation.*

5) This allegation is incorrect. I have not announced my candidacy, nor have I received or spent any funds.
