Dear Glen Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on April 10, 2017. Your complaint alleged that Clark County Democratic Central Committee may have violated by RCW 42.17A.240 and RCW 42.17A.445 for not accurately reporting debt, contributions, and expenditures.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

The allegations contained in the complaint underlying PDC Case 16809 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint, filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765.

On April 5, 2018, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 16809 was filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State.

The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint; the PDC will defer to their judgment in bringing the issues to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
