FINAL ORDER

I. INTRODUCTION

This matter was heard by the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission (Commission) on May 25, 2017 at the Public Disclosure Commission Office, 711 Capitol Way, Room 206, Olympia, Washington 98504. The hearing was held pursuant to RCW 34.05, RCW 42.17A, and WAC 390-37. The proceeding was open to the public and recorded.

Commissioners Anne Levinson, Chair, John Bridges, Vice Chair, Katrina Asay, Jack Johnson and David Ammons were present. Kurt Young, Compliance Officer, presented the matter on behalf of Public Disclosure Commission Staff (Staff). Chad Standifer, Assistant Attorney General, was also present on behalf of Staff. With the exception of Josie Delvin who was present by phone, Respondents were not present. Also present during the hearing was Penny Allen, Assistant Attorney General, on behalf of the Commission, Heather Kintzley,

7 All other allegations associated with this Complaint and various supplement materials,
8 PDC No. 2311, are hereby DISMISSED with the exception of those allegations filed in Citizens
9 for Safe Communities PAC, PDC No. 16062, David Giles, PDC No. 16070, Ken Hohenberg,
10 PDC No. 16059, Steven Keane, PDC No. 16072, Brian McElroy, PDC No. 16468, Chris Skinner
11 PDC No. 16066, that have been separately adjudicated, and those allegations associated with a
Benton County Law and Justice Council meeting held on September 25, 2013 for which warning
letters were sent to Eric Hsu, Al Wehner, Ken Hohenberg, Josie Delvin, Andy Miller and Paul
Warden.

12 The Executive Director is authorized to enter this order on behalf of the Commission.
