

File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

To Whom it Must Concern --

It has come to my attention that Roger Flygare -- a 2017 candidate for the Federal Way City Council -- has failed to submit certain reports to the PDC as required by state law.

1) Violation of RCW 42.17A.205 (1), see RCW 42.17A.005 (7) -- Failure to timely file statement of organization C1 report.

According to the PDC, candidates are required to file their C1 report within 2 weeks of becoming a candidate, as defined by **RCW 42.17A.005 (7)**.

Flygare "became a candidate" on 12/19/2016, when he announced that he would be running for Federal Way City Council.

That official announcement was referenced in a Federal Way Mirror story published on 12/20/2016. (See Exhibit A).

As such, Flygare was statutorily obligated to submit his C1 statement of organization report by 1/2/2017.

Unfortunately, Flygare failed to do this, therefore violating state law. Flygare should file his C1 immediately.

2) Violation of RCW 42.17A.700 (2) -- Failure to timely file F1 personal financial affairs statement.

According to the PDC, all candidates are required to file their F1 report within 2 weeks of becoming a candidate, as defined by **RCW 42.17A.005 (7)**.

Flygare "became a candidate" on 12/19/2016, when he announced that he would be running for Federal Way City Council.

That official announcement was referenced in a Federal Way Mirror story published on 12/20/2016. (See Exhibit A).

As such, Flygare was statutorily obligated to submit his F1 personal financial affairs statement by 1/2/2017.

Unfortunately, Flygare failed to do this, therefore violating state law. Flygare should file his C1 immediately.

3) Violation of RCW 42.17A.235 -- Failure to file timely file C3 contribution and C4 expenditure reports.

State law requires that candidates submit regular C3 and C4 reports with the PDC.

Unfortunately, despite being a candidate for over 3 months, Flygare has not submitted a single report C3 or C4 report with the PDC.

This is a serious violation that should be investigated immediately.

Summary

Roger Flygare is actively campaigning for a position on the Federal Way City Council. Flygare is also actively pursuing endorsements and financial support of various organizations.

As a candidate, Flygare is statutorily obligated to submit his C1 and F1 to the PDC. He is also obligated to file regular C3 and C4 reports detailing the contributions received and expenditures made by his committee.

Unfortunately, Flygare has failed to comply with state law in this regard.

As a four-time failed candidate for public office, Flygare is well aware of PDC requirements and should be held accountable for these violations.

I urge the PDC to investigate and adjudicate these claims as quickly as possible.

After a “great deal of deliberation” over the weekend, Roger Flygare announced on Monday the withdrawal of his application for the soon-to-be vacant Federal Way City Council position. The position will be vacated by Councilwoman Kelly Maloney, who announced her resignation in [October](#), at the end of this month.

“It is my opinion that the voters of Federal Way should decide who is on the City Council and I will abide by their decision when all votes have been tallied,” Flygare said in his announcement. “However, I would like to thank my supporters who have sent in letters of recommendation on my behalf.”

The City Council will interview nine [candidates](#) before making a final decision in January 2017.
