**RE: Citizen Action Notice - City of Kent
Notice of Results**

Dear Mr. Morgan:

The Attorney General's Office has completed its initial review of your citizen action notice against the City of Kent received from you on March 6, 2017. Your notice alleges that the City of Kent violated RCW 42.17A.555. That statute applies to conduct of any "elective official [n]or any employee of his or her office [n]or any person appointed to or employed by any public office or agency," and not to public agencies. As such, the City cannot violate the statute. We do note that you have filed a claim against Kent City Council member Dana Ralph making a similar allegation. Your allegation against Ms. Ralph will be addressed through your notice against her. However, since statute does not apply to the City's conduct, the AGO will not be taking any further action on this notice.
