**Notice of Results**

Dear Mr. Morgan:

I am writing on behalf of the Attorney General's Office concerning the citizen action notice you sent to this office on March 2, 2017 regarding Nicole Hill. Specifically, your notice alleges that Ms. Hill committed several violations of the state campaign finance and disclosure laws contained in RCW 42.17A related to her form F-1. We also noted that you filed a complaint with the state Public Disclosure Commission making the same allegations.

The Attorney General's Office has reviewed your allegations and Ms. Hill's response. We have determined, in an exercise of our prosecutorial discretion, that the allegations are more appropriate for resolution by the Public Disclosure Commission, as opposed to the superior court. The Commission has primary jurisdiction over the allegations because you first filed the complaint there; as such, any decision on how to respond to the allegations will be left with the Commission. Following review, the Commission may institute an enforcement proceeding related to your notice. If you have further questions, please contact me at (360) 586-0710.
