Dear Mr. Morgan:

I am writing to advise you of the actions taken by the Attorney General's Office following receipt of the citizen action notice you filed against the above Respondent. Your complaint was received on February 7, 2017. Your 10-day notice was received on March 30, 2017.

The notice alleged numerous violations of state campaign finance disclosure laws. Following an investigation by the Attorney General's Office, we initiated a civil enforcement action in Thurston County Superior Court against Representative Peterson and his committee concerning allegations of untimely reporting of campaign debts and obligations; untimely filing of the Candidate Registration form and reporting of contributions received; and failure to break down expenditures. A copy of the complaint is enclosed.
