

File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that People for Thurston -- sponsored and orchestrated by JZ Knight, a Yelm based cult leader -- has committed an additional violation of RCW 42.17A. In this case, the committee violated state law by including the wrong name of the piece on their mailers. The mailer was required to have JZ Knight's name in the committee name.

JZ Knight contribution to People for Thurston occurred on 10/12/2016. When this contribution occurred, Knight's donation exceeded the 80% threshold for becoming a "sponsor" of a committee.

Per WAC 390-16-011A (3), when an entity surpasses this threshold, the C1PC must be amended to include the sponsor's name in the committee name, within 10 business days, per RCW 42.17A.205 (4). In this case the committee's name was "People for Thurston".

(It is entirely possible, and indeed likely, that JZ had pledged this money prior to the PACs formation, in which case the correct sponsor should have been identified immediately. Jay Manning must be asked when JZ Knight pledged her \$56k donation. It is unlikely Jay Manning would have been involved with this PAC without JZ Knight's prior financial commitment as he has a long-term legal and personal relationship with JZ Knight)

The 10 business day time period lapsed on October 26th. Two final mailers were sent out on the 31st, both of which failed to include JZ Knight's name in the committee name. This is a violation of RCW 42.17A.320, failure to include the correct sponsor ID.

After the time period following Knight's donation, it should have been amended to include her name, reading something to the effect of "People for Thurston -- Sponsored by JZ Knight". However this did not happen.

Both Jay Manning and Christian Sinderman are well versed in PDC requirements, but choose to deliberately leave Knight's name out of the committee name because she is well known in Thurston as the leader of a cult and promotes hate. Voters would have been less receptive to the message in the mailers if they had known who the true sponsor of the committee was.

JZ Knight is a politically toxic cult leader who pretends to channel a 35,000 year old genocidal Lemurian warrior named "Ramtha". During her rituals, she drinks wine on a stage until she becomes drunk and then rails against Jews, Mexicans, Catholics, organic farmers, and gays in front of her crowd of dedicated disciples.

Among other incendiary remarks, JZ Knight has said that "[the jews] should have enough money by now to buy their way out of the gas chamber". She has also decried "the invasion of the Mexicans, who breed like rabbits" and said that "Mexicans are poison" and "Not worthy of conscious thought."

According to a study by the Southern Poverty Law Center, Knight is quoted and celebrated by Neo-Nazis.

She is so politically toxic, that the Washington State Democratic Party rejected her large 65k donation in 2012. Congressional Candidate Denny Heck and Thurston County Commissioner Candidate Sandra Romero also rejected smaller donations from her that same year. Her well-known and publicized hateful rhetoric was the incentive for Jay Manning to illegally include the wrong sponsor name on the mailings.

I urge the Commission to investigate this charge immediately and take action against Mr. Manning.
