Dear Mr. Stutzman:

Please accept this letter as a formal complaint to the Public Disclosure Commission regarding a print ad done by FPIW Action supporting Vicki Kraft and Lynda Wilson and opposing Sam Kim and Tim Probst, for state representative and state senate respectively, in the 17th Legislative District.

The attached mailer, which began arriving in mail boxes on Friday, November 4, 2016, does not state a Party preference for Ms. Kraft or Ms. Wilson nor Mr. Kim or Mr. Probst, and thus does not comply with the General Requirements section of the Public Disclosure Commission's handout titled *Political Advertising*, which requires:

- a. All forms of political advertising must clearly state a candidate's party preference if the candidate is seeking partisan office. This requirement applies regardless of whether the ad is sponsored by the candidate or someone else.

I respectfully request that the Public Disclosure Commission investigate this matter and instruct FPIW Action to stop producing unlawful advertisements.
