I am the Treasurer for the Committee to Elect Larry Seaquist. Today is the first contact made with me regarding the message shown below. I was in Europe from October 20 to November 6, 2016, with no access to the internet. The Assistant Treasurer, Jo Rodman, was handling bill payments and reports while I was away.

Upon my return I became aware, by checking the report filing menu, that several reports had not been filed and I immediately filed all reports that had not been filed. Asst. Treasurer Jo advised me that she had a problem filing reports, had phoned Chip at the PDC for advice and believed that she had filed all reports. Investigation indicated that she had followed only the first steps for an upload and failed to click on the last step, therefore the reports had not been filed.

As to reporting expenses and expenditures, all I can say is that each item was entered into ORCA as it was paid, that to the best of my knowledge all bills were paid in a timely manner and as presented and the information as to what was purchased is as shown on invoices. I am not aware of any media buy not being accurately reported. In my capacity as Treasurer, I reacted to invoices, paid them and reported them. I was not part of media or other buys.
