**RE: Citizen Action Notice – Andrew Biviano**

Dear Ms. Lopez:

On October 27, 2016, the Attorney General received a Citizen Action Notice from Glen Morgan, alleging that Andrew Biviano violated provisions of RCW 42.17A. Specifically, the notice alleged that Mr. Biviano violated state laws by failing to 1) timely file his candidate registration C-1 form, 2) include a “paid for by” statement on his webpage, 3) report the expenditure or in-kind contribution of the purchase of his website domain, 4) accurately report debt, 5) report the expenditure or in-kind contribution for the professional video on his website, and 6) include sponsor and partisan identification in the video on his website. The 45 days under RCW 42.17A.765 expires on December 11, 2016. I note that Mr. Morgan also filed this complaint with the PDC.

I would ask that you review and possibly investigate the allegations as needed. I will await the results of that review and any recommendation the Commission may have. I would request with the Commission’s recommendation, a copy of any report of investigation or materials the Commission staff may produce when available.
