STIPULATION AS TO FACTS,
VIOLATIONS AND PENALTY

The parties to this Stipulation, the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) Staff, through its Executive Director, Peter Lavallee, and Respondent House Republican Organizational Committee, through Mark Lamb, legal counsel, submit this Stipulation as to Facts, Violations and Penalty in this matter. The parties agree that the Commission has the authority to accept, reject or modify the terms of this Stipulation. The parties further agree that in the event that the Commission suggests modification to any term of this agreement, each party reserves the right to reject that modification. In the event either party rejects a modification, this matter will proceed to hearing before the Commission.

JURISDICTION

The Public Disclosure Commission has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to RCW 42.17A, the state campaign finance and disclosure laws; RCW 34.05, the Administrative Procedure Act; and WAC 390.

FACTS

1. The House Republican Organizational Committee (HROC) supports Republican legislative candidates seeking the office of State Representative. HROC has been registered and reporting with the PDC dating back to at least 1994, and prior to that, HROC filed reports as the House Republican PAC.
2. On July 10, 2012, HROC filed an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) with the PDC as a continuing committee listing Army Davis as COO-CFO, and Samantha Cotton as

Treasurer. The amended C-1pc report filed by HROC was in effect throughout the 2016 election cycle, and the first six months of 2017.

3. On September 12, 2016, HROC timely filed the 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report covering the period of July 26 through August 31, 2016, disclosing \$943,000 in monetary contributions received and \$25,551 in expenditures made. The C-4 report disclosed two expenditures to ADP for HROC Payroll, fees and taxes totaling \$25,126.
4. The C-4 report disclosed that no contributions were made by HROC to any candidates, or bona fide political party organization during the reporting period covered by the 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report.
5. On September 25, 2017, HROC filed an amended Post-Primary Election C-4 report disclosing eight new expenditures in the form of monetary contributions totaling \$85,000 that were disclosed 378 days late, and more than 10 months after the November 8, 2016 general election had been held.
6. The late reported HROC expenditures included a \$50,000 monetary contribution made to the Washington State Republican Party Non-Exempt funds account on August 30, 2016. In addition, the C-4 report disclosed seven previously unreported monetary contribution totaling \$35,000, \$5,000 each to the following 2016 Legislative candidates seeking the office of State Representative: Phil Fortunato; Teri Hickel; Janice Huxford; Linda Kochmar; Vicki Kraft; Jim Walsh; and Jesse Young.

STATUTORY AND RULE AUTHORITY

RCW 42.17A.005(8) states that "Caucus political committee" means a political committee organized and maintained by the members of a major political party in the state senate or state house of representatives.


RCW 42.17A.235 and **RCW 42.17A.240** requires political committees, including caucus political committees to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including monetary contributions made to candidates, and bona fide political party organization, on C-4 reports that are required 21 and 7 days before each election, and in the month following the election, regardless of the level of activity.

VIOLATIONS

1. Based on the Stipulation of Facts set forth above, Respondent House Republican Organizational Committee stipulates that the committee violated RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 by failing to timely disclose \$85,000 in monetary contributions made to seven 2016 candidates for State Representative, and one bona-fide political party organization on a C-4 reports.


PENALTY

1. Based upon the Stipulation of Facts and Violations set forth above, Respondent House Republican Organizational Committee agrees to pay a total civil penalty of \$10,000.
2. Respondent House Republican Organizational Committee affirms its intention to comply in good faith with the provisions of RCW 42.17A and WAC 390 in the future.

Notice of Administrative Charges

I. Jurisdiction

1. The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 42.17A RCW, the state's campaign disclosure and contribution law; Chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative Procedure Act; and Title 390 WAC. These charges incorporate the Report of Investigation and all related exhibits by reference.

II. Allegations

2. PDC staff alleges that the House Republican Organizational Committee, the caucus political committee registered with the PDC and comprised of Republican members of the Washington State House of Representatives, violated RCW 42.17A.235 and 42.17A.240 by failing to timely disclose \$85,000 in monetary contributions made to seven 2016 candidates for State Representative, and one bona-fide political party organization on Summary Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports).

III. Facts

3. The House Republican Organizational Committee (HROC) supports Republican legislative candidates seeking the office of State Representative. HROC has been registered and reporting with the PDC since at least 1994, and prior to that, they filed reports as the House Republican PAC.

4. On July 10, 2012, HROC filed an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) with the PDC as a continuing committee listing Army Davis as COO-CFO, and Samantha Cotton as Treasurer. The amended C-1pc report filed by HROC was in effect throughout the 2016 election cycle, and the first six months of 2017.
5. On September 12, 2016, HROC timely filed the 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report covering the period of July 26 through August 31, 2016, disclosing \$943,000 in monetary contributions received and \$25,551 in expenditures made, and included two expenditures to ADP for HROC Payroll, fees and taxes totaling \$25,126.
6. No contributions were disclosed by HROC as having been made to any candidates, or bona fide political party organization on the 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report.
7. PDC staff reviewed the complaint filed against HROC on October 21, 2016, alleging that HROC failed to disclose contributions made to 2016 legislative candidates and a political party organization. Staff reviewed the 2016 C-4 reports filed by HROC, and queried the PDC expenditure database for HROC expenditures for the 2016 election cycle. Staff's review confirmed that the alleged unreported HROC contributions listed in the complaint, had not been disclosed on any C-4 report filed by HROC during calendar year 2016.
8. PDC also staff reviewed the Monetary Contributions report (C-3 reports) filed by the seven candidates listed in the complaint and the Washington State Republican Party (WSRP), that were alleged to have received contributions from HROC. Staff's review found the alleged unreported contributions made by HROC, had been timely received, deposited and disclosed on C-3 reports filed by the seven candidates and the WSRP, and were also listed in the PDC contribution database.
9. On September 25, 2017, HROC filed an amended Post-Primary Election C-4 report covering the period of July 26 through August 31, 2016. The amended 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report filed by HROC disclosed eight new expenditures in the form of monetary contributions totaling \$85,000 that were disclosed 378 days late, and more than 10 months after the November 8, 2016 general election had been held.

10. The late reported HROC expenditures were monetary contributions made to seven 2016 candidates for State Representative, and a political party organization, as follows:

Report of Investigation

I.

Background. Complaint and Allegations

- 1.1 The House Republican Organizational Committee (HROC) is the caucus political committee registered with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC), and has been filing reports with the PDC since the late 1980's. HROC is made up of Republican members of the Washington State House of Representatives.
- 1.2 HROC supports Republican legislative candidates seeking the office of State Representative. As a caucus political committee, HROC can contribute \$1 for every registered voter in a legislative district to a legislative candidate for an election cycle.
- 1.3 HROC has been registered and, and prior to that, they filed reports as the House Republican PAC. The Reagan Fund has been registered and reporting with the PDC since March 8, 2007. HROC and The Reagan Fund share staff, office, and overhead costs, and are related political committees.
- 1.4 On July 10, 2012, HROC filed an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) with the PDC as a continuing committee listing Arny Davis as COO-CFO, and Samantha Cotton as Treasurer. The amended C-1pc report filed by HROC was in effect throughout the 2016 election cycle.
- 1.5 On July 7, 2017, HROC filed an amended Committee Registration (C-1pc report) with the PDC as a continuing committee listing JT Wilcox as Chair, Cary Condotta, Co-Chair, and Andrew Aboen as Treasurer.

- 1.6 On October 21, 2016, Mina Mercer with the House Democratic Campaign Committee filed a complaint with the PDC, alleging that HROC violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to disclose expenditures made in the form of monetary contributions to seven candidates, and two monetary contributions to a bona fide state political party organization on Summary Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Report (C-4 report). **Exhibit #1.** Specifically, the complaint alleged that HROC failed to disclose monetary contributions made to seven Republican candidates for State Representative in 2016, and the Washington State Republican Party (WSRP).
- 1.7 A complaint was filed against The Reagan Fund by another staff member for the House Democratic Campaign Committee, alleging a violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failing to disclose a contribution to a bona fide county political party organization. The Reagan Fund is a political committee registered with the Public Disclosure Commission, as a caucus related political committee with ties to HROC. HROC and The Reagan Fund share staff, office, and overhead costs. The complaint against The Reagan Fund is being investigated under PDC Case 9343, and will be handled separately.

II. **Findings**

- 2.1 Caucus political committees such as HROC that selected the Full Reporting option, and participated in the 2016 election by supporting or opposing candidates, were required to file weekly Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 report) beginning June 1, 2016. HROC was also required to file the following C-4 reports:
 - Monthly C-4 reports are due to be filed by the 10th of each month disclosing contribution and expenditure information for activities undertaken during the previous calendar month.
 - A 21-day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report was due on July 12, 2016, covering the period June 1 through July 11, 2016; and a 7-day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report was due on July 26, 2016, covering the period July 12 through July 25, 2016.
 - A Post-Primary Election C-4 report was due by September 12, 2016, covering the period July 26 through August 31, 2016.
- 2.2 On September 12, 2016, HROC timely filed the 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report covering the period of July 26 through August 31, 2016, disclosing the receipt of \$943,000 in monetary contributions received and \$25,551 in expenditures made. **Exhibit #2.** The \$25,551 in expenditures that were disclosed on the 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report included two expenditures to ADP for HROC Payroll, fees and taxes totaling \$25, 126. No contributions were disclosed as having been made to any candidates, or bonafide political party organizations on the C-4 report.
- 2.3 PDC staff reviewed the complaint, the 2016 C-4 reports filed by HROC, and queried the PDC expenditure database for HROC expenditures for the 2016 election cycle.

- 2.4 Staff found that the alleged unreported contributions listed in the complaint were not disclosed on any C-4 report filed by HROC during calendar year 2016. In addition, there were no records in the PDC database concerning HROC expenditures in the form of monetary contributions to the seven candidates and the WSRP, as listed in the complaint.
- 2.5 PDC staff reviewed the Monetary Contributions report (C-3 reports) filed by the seven candidates and the WSRP for HROC 2016 election related contributions, as well as querying the PDC contribution database. **Exhibit #3 – database download and printout of candidate and WSRP contributions received from HROC.** Staff found that the candidates and the WSRP as noted below, disclosed receiving the following monetary contributions during the 2016 election:

- 2.6 On September 20, 2017, Mark Lamb, an attorney with the North Creek Law Firm, sent an email to PDC staff on behalf of his clients HROC and The Reagan Fund. **Exhibit #4.** In the email, Mr. Lamb stated the following:

“The Reagan Fund and House Republican Organizational Committee both encountered difficulties in reporting due to the oversight of an employee (Andrew Aboen) in 2016.”

“Mr. Aboen was given responsibility to transmit the relevant spending and contribution information to the PDC but (on the occasions outlined in the complaints) he did not timely do so. Although the transactions at issue represent a very small amount of the activity undertaken by both committees (and were reported timely and accurately by other entities so the public was aware of the activity), Mr. Aboen sincerely regrets the error as does the Reagan Fund and HROC.”

“The Reagan Fund and HROC have amended all of the relevant reports at issue in the complaints.” “The committees have further taken the step of retaining a new outside PDC compliance specialist who will review all filings and advise both committees on internal controls to ensure this does not occur again.”

2.7 On September 25, 2017, HROC filed an amended C-4 report have 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report covering the period of July 26 through August 31, 2016. The amended 2016 Post-Primary Election C-4 report filed by HROC disclosed eight contributions totaling \$85,000 that were disclosed 378 days late, and more than 10 months after the November 8, 2016 general election had been held. The eight late reported contributions included the following:

III. **Scope**

3.1 PDC staff reviewed the following documents:

- The complaint and exhibits filed on October 21, 2016, by Mina Mercer against HROC.
- Telephone conversations and email communications with Andy Aboen, with HROC.
- Email communications between Mark Lamb, legal counsel for HROC and PDC staff.
- 2016 C-4 reports filed by HROC.
- C-3 reports filed by seven 2016 Legislative candidates for State Representative and the WSRP.

3.2 Queried the PDC Contribution and Expenditure database for HROC information.

3.3 Chronology of PDC staff contacts with HROC concerning the complaint:

- Email with attached complaint sent to HROC email address on October 25, 2016. (No response received)
- Email with attached complaint sent to HROC email address on December 19, 2016. (No response received)

- Letter with attached complaint mailed to HROC mailing address listed on the C-1pc report on March 3, 2017. (No response received)
- Email with attached complaint sent to Representative Gary Chandler's email address on May 22, 2016. (No response received)
- On August 18, PDC staff spoke with Andy Aboen, Treasurer for HROC by telephone concerning the complaints filed against HROC and The Reagan Fund. After the telephone conversation, staff sent Mr. Aboen an email attaching copies of the two complaints, and requesting a response to the allegations no later than August 26, 2017. Mr. Aboen responded by email stating that HROC's attorney was reviewing the complaints and working on the responses
- On August 28, 2017, Mark Lamb, attorney representing HROC and The Reagan Fund, sent an email to the PDC requesting that staff contact him concerning the complaints that had been filed by HROC and The Reagan Fund.
- PDC staff spoke with Mr. Lamb around August 29th or 30th, in which he stated he recently received copies of the complaints, and requested additional time to review the allegations, and prepare a response. Staff granted HROC and The Reagan Fund, through Mr. Lamb an extension until September 15, 2017 to submit a response to the complaints.
- On September 20, 2017, Mr. Lamb sent an email to PDC staff responding to the allegations in the complaints filed against HROC and The Reagan Fund.

IV.

Statutes and Rules

- 4.1 **RCW 42.17A.005(8)** states that "'Caucus political committee" means a political committee organized and maintained by the members of a major political party in the state senate or state house of representatives."
- 4.2 **RCW 42.17A.235(1 and 2)** state the following: "(1) In addition to the information required under RCW 42.17A.205 and 42.17A.210, on the day the treasurer is designated, each candidate or political committee must file with the commission a report of all contributions received and expenditures made prior to that date, if any. (2) Each treasurer shall file with the commission a report containing the information required by RCW 42.17A.240 at the following intervals:....Reports filed on the tenth day of the month shall report all contributions received and expenditures made from the closing date of the last report filed through the last day of the month preceding the date of the current report."
- 4.3 **RCW 42.17A.240(1, 5 and 6)** states the following :“Each report required under RCW 42.17A.235 (1) and (2) must be certified as correct by the treasurer and the candidate and shall disclose the following: (1) The funds on hand at the beginning of the period; (5) The name and address of each candidate or political committee to which any transfer of funds was made, including the amounts and dates of the transfers; and

(6) The name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure, and the total sum of all expenditures.”

Please accept this letter as a formal complaint regarding improper disclosure filings by the House Republican Organizational Committee (HROC).

As of today, October 21st, 2016, HROC has failed to report nine monetary contributions they have made to seven candidates for State House and the WA State Republican Party. A list of these contributions follows and I have attached C3 reports for each contribution that was filed by the receiving party:

5,000 to Vicki Kraft, candidate for State House in the 17th District, on August 26th, 2016
5,000 to Jesse Young, candidate for State House in the 26th District, on August 26th, 2016
5,000 to James Walsh, candidate for State House in the 19th District, on September 8th, 2016
5,000 to Janice Huxford, candidate for State House in the 44th District, on August 26th, 2016
5,000 to Phil Fortunato, candidate for State House in the 31st District, on August 9th, 2016
5,000 to Linda Kochmar, candidate for State House in the 30h District, on August 11th, 2016
5,000 to Teri Hickel, candidate for State House in the 30h District, on August 11th, 2016
50,000 to the Washington State Republican Party (Non-Exempt) on September 9th, 2016
10,000 to the Washington State Republican Party (Exempt) on August 12th, 2016

I have also attached HROC's C4 reports for the periods covering July 26th through August 31st and September 1st through October 17th, where no record of these contributions can be found. HROC's Expenditure data can also be found here: <http://web.pdc.wa.gov/MvcQuerySystem/CommitteeData/expenditures?param=SE9VU1JPIDUwNw%3D%3D%3D%3D&year=2016&type=caucus>.

RCW 42.17A.225 requires that committees to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including in-kind contributions. Based on this law, HROC is not in compliance with state law, due to their failure to report and conceal nine monetary contributions totaling \$95,000.

HROC and has experienced personnel, who have been with their organization for multiple cycles, who are required by law to know the regulations surrounding the fundraising for their organization and the reporting obligations that go with that. Yet HROC repeatedly shows a disregard for our state's campaign finance laws and as recently as June, 2011 they were found guilty of violating campaign finance law and reporting requirements (case 11-025). At the time HROC claimed their failure to follow the law was due to "campaign chaos" but repeatedly breaking the law each cycle is not chaos, it is utter disregard for campaign law.

I respectfully request that the Public Disclosure Commission conduct a formal investigation and if wrongdoing is discovered impose appropriate penalties as determined by law.

Mr. Young,

The Reagan Fund and House Republican Organizational Committee both encountered difficulties in reporting due to the oversight of an employee (Andrew Aboen) in 2016. Mr. Aboen was given responsibility to transmit the relevant spending and contribution information to the PDC but (on the occasions outlined in the complaints) he did not timely do so. Although the transactions at issue represent a very small amount of the activity undertaken by both committees (and were reported timely and accurately by other entities so the public was aware of the activity), Mr. Aboen sincerely regrets the error as does the Reagan Fund and HROC.

The Reagan Fund and HROC have amended all of the relevant reports at issue in the complaints. The committees have further taken the step of retaining a new outside PDC compliance specialist who will review all filings and advise both committees on internal controls to ensure this does not occur again.

Please advise if you require anything additional to address this matter.
