Mr. Berkey,

I asked my Treasurer, Jane Roush, to look into this problem. As I suspected, there was no \$500 contribution from the Skokomish Tribe. The only \$500 donation received at all was from Judy L. Wilkins, check #5718. It was clearly an input mistake. Below is Ms. Roush's response to me. -- Roslynn Reed.

I messed up Ros, that is all I can say.

I filed the original C-3 with the PDC on July 22nd, showing \$1,000 contribution from the Skokomish Tribe. The total contributions on the C-3 are \$1,460.

The August 3rd C-4 on page 2 shows the C-3 reflecting the deposit of \$1,460.

Then I lost it. There were two small errors on the C-3, one was a contribution for \$50 which I reported as a \$60 contribution. The other was a missed \$50 contribution. When I tried to make the corrections I went off course.

For some unknown reason, I amended the original C-3 reflecting only a \$500 deposit from the Skokomish Tribe and I filed an amended (1st) C-4 on September 9th to show my correction.

I realized my error and filed a C-3 for another \$500 on September 17th. I reported the contribution as a general election contribution instead of a primary election contribution. I also made the date of July 6th and filed a 2nd amended C-4 .

At that point I was concerned that anyone looking at the C-4's might be confused so I filed a 3rd amended C-4 Oct 7th. That is my explanation. There are only two checks from the Skokomish Tribe, totaling \$2,000 consisting of a \$1,000 each contribution to the primary and general election. Plus errors on my part. Jane
