Dear Mr. Davis:


Enclosed is a copy of a letter sent to Samantha Kersul concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission on September 15, 2016. The complaint alleged that Working Families may have violated RCW 42.17A.305 by failing to file a C6 report for electioneering communications within the 24-hour deadline.

As noted in the letter to Ms. Kersul, the PDC will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking enforcement action in this matter.

Your campaign filed the C6 report 3 days after the media buy which appears to constitute a violation of RCW 42.17A.305. In accordance with WAC 390-73-060(1)(b), this is a Formal Written Warning to file all reports based on reporting requirements. If there are future violations of PDC laws or rule, the Commission will consider this Formal Written Warning in deciding on further Commission action.
