

File a Formal Complaint - Barney Burke

Barney Burke reported a day ago (Tue, 6 Sep at 8:55 AM) via Portal Meta

(1) "Slim jim" flyers do not appear to comply with sponsor ID requirements. An earlier version does not have address at all, and there is no sponsor ID on front page of ad. Later version has address, but sponsor ID is still not on front page as required.

(2) Campaign expenditure report indicates just \$72.88 on April 8 for slim jims. It appears that this is only a fraction of the cost of said ads (if typical cost is 30¢ each, this would buy less than 250). Perhaps this expenditure was not fully reported or is mis-reported as something else?




