Dear Mr. Ramdall:

Enclosed is a copy of a letter sent to Barney Burke concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission on September 6, 2016. The complaint alleged that you may have violated RCW 42.17A.235, .240, and .320 by failing to include sponsor identification on campaign materials and not reporting campaign expenditures.

As noted in the letter to Mr. Burke, the PDC will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking enforcement action in this matter.

Your campaign failed to include required sponsor identification on campaign advertisements which appears to constitute a violation of RCW 42.17A.320. In accordance with WAC 390-73-060(1)(b), this is a Formal Written Warning to include sponsor identification as required by PDC laws and rules. If there are future violations of PDC laws or rule, the Commission will consider this Formal Written Warning in deciding on further Commission action.
