Subject: Complaint regarding Clark County Republican Party, PDC Case 7934

Dear Ms. Campbell and Mr. Green:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has concluded its review and investigative work concerning the complaint you filed on August 28, 2016 and supplemented on September 14, 2016. Your complaint alleged that the Clark County Republican Party purchased mailers and incurred other expenditures during the 2016 elections, but did not timely report its expenditures on C-4 reports, and in some cases as Independent Expenditures on C-6 reports, between May and August 2016, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235, .240, and .305.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's review and investigative work, we found the following:


- The allegations contained in your complaint underlying PDC Case 7934 are substantially similar to a citizen action complaint filed with the Attorney General's Office pursuant to RCW 42.17A.765 by Walter Smith on September 1, 2017.
- On October 27, 2017, the PDC became aware that a lawsuit containing substantially similar allegations as the complaint underlying PDC Case 7934 was filed in Superior Court in the name of Washington State by the Attorney General's Office.
- The Superior Court now has primary jurisdiction over the substance of this complaint, and the PDC will defer to their judgment in bringing the issues in your complaint to resolution.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting further investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.


