This Washington nonprofit organization, CORE, is holding a political fundraiser for Senator Ann Rivers and labeling it a reception. The group has had various receptions in the pasts where they invited legislators and political figures, but this is the first attempt to influence an election.

The group has three registered lobbyists. However, CORE, not the lobbyists, have sent an email to every retailer inviting them to this political fundraising event. CORE is organizing and making expenditures to influence an election. Even if the checks to attend to the event are made out to Friends of Ann Rivers, the organization is collecting the funds and doing the fundraiser on behalf of Mrs. Rivers.

It appears this organization, which maintains as one of its purposes to influence elections, has not registered as a political action committee in accordance with RCW 42.17A. It appears this organization is trying to influence an election and evade registering as a PAC by calling its event a "reception."

It is registered with the IRS as a non-profit lobbying organization.

In a prior presentation they mentioned their purpose was to influence elections. At the time, I was inquiring about membership and told them that I did not see them registered as a PAC. 




