Please accept this letter as a formal complaint to the Public Disclosure Commission regarding a mail piece produced and mailed to voters by Move Clark County Forward, an independent expenditure Political Action Committee. Top Contributor: David E. Barnett.

The attached mailer, which began arriving in mailboxes on July 18th, 2016, does not state a Party affiliation for Alishia Topper, State Representative 49th LD Position 2 (D) and thus does not comply with the General Requirements section of the Public Disclosure Commission's handout titled *Political Advertising*, which requires:


Party preference must be included in any form of advertising about a candidate seeking election to a partisan office, regardless of who sponsors the ad.

Furthermore, Move Clark County Forward, an independent expenditure Political Action Committee. Top Contributor: David E. Barnett. does not comply with RCW 42.17A.320 which states:

For partisan office, if a candidate has expressed a party or independent preference on the declaration of candidacy, that party or independent designation shall be clearly identified in electioneering communications, independent expenditures, or political advertising.


I respectfully request that an investigation into this unlawful mailer be launched immediately, and that Mr. Barnett be contacted without delay and instructed to stop mailing out additional unlawful mailers in this election.



THIS YEAR, VOTERS IN VANCOUVER HAVE A REAL CHOICE.

On July 15th, 2015 the Governor signed the revenue bill which increased the gas tax to 11.9 cents. Stonier voted against a funding bill that included a new bridge across the Columbia River when she was in the legislature—after she was defeated the legislature passed an 11.9 cent a gallon tax increase, with no funding for our bridge.
