

File a Formal Complaint - Mike P Tiufekchiev

Mike P Tiufekchiev reported 2 days ago (Mon, 2 May at 5:37 PM) via Portal Meta

RCW 42.17A.700(2) requires candidates for public office to file a financial affairs statement "within two weeks of becoming a candidate." Tim Probst became a candidate for the 17th legislative district senate seat when he filed his C1 candidate registration on January 22, 2016. However, a subsequent public document request revealed that as of April 29, 2016 Mr. Probst has yet to file the required F-1 financial disclosure form. This is in clear violation of the statute, and I request the PDC investigate this matter promptly and take any necessary remedial actions.
