Subject: Complaint regarding John Henry, PDC Case 41016

Dear Jason Raines:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on September 17, 2018. Your complaint alleged that John Henry may have violated RCW 42.17A.710 for failure to accurately and completely disclose financial activity for calendar year 2017.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff’s initial review, we found the following:

- On April 14, 2018, John Henry attempted to electronically file an F-1 report disclosing financial activities in calendar year 2017, as required by RCW 42.17A.700.
- John Henry encountered technical limitations within the electronic F-1 filing application, and inadvertently filed a blank report.
- John Henry made multiple attempts to file at direction of PDC staff, and each time encountered errors.
- On November 13, 2018, John Henry successfully filed a paper version of the F-1 report disclosing financial activities in calendar year 2017.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to file an accurate and complete F-1 report due to technical errors, does not amount to an actual material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding John Henry about the importance of the accurate and complete disclosure of financial activities on the F-1 report.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1), and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
