The candidate looks nothing like these photos. Attached are the photos from her original 2014 primary campaign photo...by 2015 she already looks nothing like the 2014 photo, as you can see by her candidate swearing in. In real life, the candidate is clearly much different looking and older than depicted in the largest photos in her political ads, which are clearly more than 5 years old.

What impact does the alleged violation(s) have on the public?

Mosbrucker's campaign signs and SOS voters' guide photo, as well as Twitter photo, is more than 5 years old. The real candidate would be unrecognizable to the public.
