

RESPONSE TO COMPLAINT FROM THE PDC FROM COMPLAINANT STACY WEIGLE

The Complainant's complaint regarding any alleged violations is meritless and should be dismissed. I believe that the complaint is biased, partial, and part of a larger agenda. I believe this for the following:

First, the complainant does not provide notice as to the date and times of the alleged violations. The Complaint states that the violations occurred at the Fair, but does not identify the date, times, and actual names and addresses of voters that claim that they were misled or confused. As mentioned in a previous complaint regarding the same complaint made on or about October 3, 2018, my party affiliation was and has been on all of my materials once I learned of the error. All materials that were noncompliant were destroyed. There are no new allegations in this complaint from the previous one made by Mrs. Pieper, and the complaint is duplicative. Also, the complaint was lodged more than thirty days after the incident occurred leaving no opportunity to address or correct any issues in real time. Since the Fair, I have advertised an 11ft by 24ft billboard and in the Chronicle newspaper. Both of these advertisements are fully compliant, which is why they are not part of this complaint. There have been no other advertisements as I have not had time to print more materials. Therefore, for the past two months, I have campaigned at a disadvantage to my opponent by having no literature whatsoever. In addition, while campaigning, I announced on the radio that I am a republican, in public, I also yell that I am a republican, and I believe the entire County knows that I am republican whether or not they are part of that party affiliation. I also interviewed in the Methow Valley News, Gazette Tribune, Quad City Herald, and other local publications, which I have always told the reporter and they have quoted me as republican.

I submit that the Complainant is not confused or misled. The Complainant is the Vice Chair of the Okanogan County Democrats, she ran for legislative district 12 in this election cycle, and her party and local Okanogan County Chapter endorsed my opponent. She knows exactly who I am, the office I am running for, and my party affiliation. In fact, she advertises the democratic candidates that she wants the public to vote for on her Facebook page. They are all democrats as her publications and statements clearly state that she does not align with the Republican party. See attached evidence. Nor does the complainant identify any persons actually confused or misled. Complainant has no evidence of confusion merely allegations and conclusions that are not supported by any evidence.

Third, this complaint is also duplicative as this complaint is identical to one already complained of in an October 3, 2018 complaint by Mrs. Peiper. A quick check of the PDC website demonstrates that Mrs. Peiper is a financial contributor of my opponent proving that she was never confused by my party affiliation; she simply wants me to lose. This complaint is more of the same and is meritless and baseless.

As stated before, when I initially advertised my candidacy, I thought that the GOP had to endorse me before I used the party affiliation in advertising. I have been prominently endorsed by the republican party since the advertising was placed.


Since the earlier errors were corrected all of my other advertisements comply with the PDC rules, which is why the complainant did not submit those advertisements to the PDC. Since the advertisement, the County voted in the primary. On the ballot, I am listed as republican. We have roughly 22,000 registered voters in the county. About 10,500 voted in the primary. I submit that the public is not confused as evidenced by the primary voting results. Therefore, any errors that I made caused no harm, confusion, damage, or anything else to the public. I certainly never misled anyone. Once again, I do not believe that the advertisement or anything else has caused any serious harm to the public or any individual, and any violations if they actually happened were minor at best. The corrective measures I employed is that all my advertising since these errors has been corrected (see all recent advertisements in other periodicals, which were not provided to the PDC).

With respect to the 3 X 5 informational cards, I destroyed all of the remaining materials. In the event that these corrective measures are not satisfactory, I will destroy them as well. All of my banners have also been marked by gigantic party affiliation writing and addresses. Any other paper was not required to have a "R" on it. I believe that all measures have been taken to correct any confusion although I do not believe any confusion ever existed at all, nor did complainant meet there burden of proof that the public was harmed by any errors of the campaign regarding "R" being placed on advertisement.

I ask that this matter be deemed to not be any violation (or merely duplicative), and close this matter.

C. Keiki Stacy Weigle aka "MamaKeiki Hula" is a proud Multicultural/Multiracial HAPA woman with strong ties to her Chinese, Hawaiian, Cherokee, Irish, Scottish, English and French roots. She was born and educated in the San Francisco Bay Area, spending breaks visiting and traveling with family throughout California, Nevada, Washington and Hawaii. Because of her own early-in-life experiences with racial and gender discrimination, as well as civil unrest brought about by the war in Vietnam, racial prejudice and labor abuses, Keiki has been involved as an activist for equal rights, fair/equal pay, anti-discrimination and AAPI since 1975, when she and her mother marched with Caesar Chavez.

A 35+ year technology industry veteran, Keiki started her career in the heart of Silicon Valley in 1978 with Advanced Micro Devices, where she was recruited by Sperry Univac Defense Systems Division to manage semiconductor procurement for the Trident and Minute Man Missile program. Throughout the 1980's, her career path lead her to live and work throughout the USA, Germany and Australia. She feels fortunate to have ridden the "roller coaster of Silicon Valley, having worked in sales, marketing, contracts administration and business development for some of the most innovative companies in the technology field. From personal computer manufacturers to software developers, from network security systems to the Internet, and from virtual world simulation education to gaming entertainment – Keiki says "I was blessed to be a member of such wonderful teams throughout my professional career. We all worked hard, supported each other without fail, tapped into exposing each other's creative energies and thought out of the box, with innovative approaches, so we could ride each wave relentlessly."

Keiki moved with her family from Palm Beach County, Florida to Okanogan County in the spring of 2015. She is grateful that the move has brought her closer to her family and roots in an area close to her heart. Having spent many of her youth's fishing and hunting seasons with her father in Okanogan County.

As the presidential race led into the debates and primaries, Keiki knew it was time to step up, speak out and take action. She has been honored to serve in these roles, work with the membership, support the efforts to build a new blue democratic party in her county, help automate some functions, redesign the organization's website, as well as launch its social media presence. Having coined the term (and hashtag) "TheNewBlue" on Twitter, Keiki says "I was excited about learning how purple our county was after moving here, and I'm even more excited and optimistic about working with the OCDCC's board, PCO's and members to secure viable and progressive-minded candidates to flip those old red seats throughout Okanogan County being filled by #TheNewBlue!"
