To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this letter as a formal complaint to the Public Disclosure Commission concerning multiple violations by Sen. Doug Ericksen and his campaign. Ericksen failed to report income from the Trump Presidential campaign on his F-1 form, and his campaign failed to include legally required "paid for by" language on his campaign advertising.

According to FEC spending records, Ericksen was paid \$38,739.15 for "field consulting" by the Donald J. Trump for President campaign in 2016. This income earned by Ericksen was not reported on his F-1 personal financial affairs form for 2016, both of which are attached. As stated in RCW 42.17A.700, after January 1st and before April 15th of each year, every elected official shall file with the commission a statement of financial affairs for the preceding calendar year. Ericksen's report for 2016 appears to be inaccurate and in violation.

The attached video in support of Doug Ericksen for State Senate on YouTube does not provide a "paid for by" disclaimer and address. This video is a clear violation of Public Disclosure Law, and combined with other violations, is evidence of a consistent lack of compliance with the PDC.
