The C4 due September 10, 2018 was filed seven days late on September 17, 2018. The Washington state campaign finance laws require every campaign to timely report its expenditures on form C4. RCW 42.17A.235, .240(8); RCW 42.17A.005(20). As the end of the campaign nears, the urgency for reporting on time becomes more important therefore there is a public interest in timely reporting.

Mr. Power is a candidate for prosecuting attorney and an attorney for Mr. Glen Morgan. He has brought four lawsuits in Thurston against Democratic Committees for late reports as short as one day. He knows the rules.

Even if the mistake was inadvertent there should be some consequence.
