Subject: Complaint regarding Thomas Taylor, PDC Case 42257

Dear Lorilee Gill:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on October 11, 2018. Your complaint alleged that Thomas Taylor may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 for failure to timely and accurately report contributions and expenditures.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff’s initial review, we found the following:

- On June 5, 2018, Thomas Taylor registered as a candidate for State Representative in the 3rd Legislative District, selecting Full Reporting, certifying that he would file frequent, detailed campaign reports of contributions and expenditures as required by RCW 42.17A.225 through RCW 42.17A.240.
- On November 8, 2018, Thomas Taylor filed an amended C-1 candidate registration form, failing to fill in the \$477.76 filing fee required for C-1 Mini Reporting registration.
- Nevertheless, on November 9, 2018, the PDC granted Thomas Taylor permission to switch to Mini Reporting, on the basis that any money raised and spent did not exceed \$5000.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, failure to accurately register as a candidate, does not an actual material violation warranting further investigation.

PDC staff is reminding Thomas Taylor about the importance of the timely disclosure of all contribution and expenditure activities, including the filing fee, and the timely filings of all future PDC reports, including the F-1 report.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1), and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
