Dear Dan Brady:

After conducting a preliminary review and assessment of a complaint filed Oct. 17, 2018 by Samantha Kersul against North Cascade Jobs Enterprise Washington, PDC staff opened a formal investigation and held an Initial Hearing (Case Status Review Hearing) on Jan. 8, 2019, pursuant to RCW 42.17A.755, and WACs 390-37-060 and 390-37-071.

At the hearing it was noted that RCW 42.17A.755 provides PDC staff with additional tools to resolve complaints through the use of alternatives to non-compliance, and I am encouraging you to work with staff on resolving this matter.

I urge you to respond to staff's request by providing any additional written statements concerning the alleged violations and by filing Independent Spending and Electioneering Communications (C-6) reports and amending Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports).
